Scientists Call For Moratorium on 5G

We appreciate that the new PACE President Stel-

la Kyriakides at the opening of a seminar in London on "Children's mental health and child-friendly justice" considered: "child protection and well-being one of the <u>Assembly's priorities</u>". We over 190 scientists and doctors have the same goal. We have signed a 5G-Appeal (see Attachment) to the Council of Europe and European Union seeking a moratorium on the deployment of 5G (Fifth Generation of Telecommunication) using super-high 10–100 GigaHz frequencies, so new that they have not scientifically been proven safe.

The scientists who signed the Appeal demand the EU and Council of Europe now – instead of to massively <u>increase</u> total exposure by adding 5G – must apply the <u>PACE Resolution 1815</u> and "take all reasonable measures necessary to <u>reduce</u> exposure to electromagnetic fields" and therefore halt the 5G expansion until an expert group of truly independent scientists can assure that 5G and the increased sum of radiation levels caused by 5G wireless technology added to 2G, 3G, 4G, Wi-Fi ¹) etc. will be safe. We ask PACE to also demand that EU follows Resolution 1815.

The signatories know that the microwave radiation emitted by lower frequency wireless technology is "harmful to humans and the environment." Deployment of 5G will substantially increase the total exposure to wireless radiation. We also referred to the EU Council recommendation (1999/519/EC) of 12 July 1999: (4) "It is imperative to protect members of the general public within the Community against established adverse health effects that may result as a consequence of exposure to electromagnetic fields." We need this for "child protection and well being" in Europe.

The current safety guidelines only recognize heating effects. The 190+ scientists are in agreement that science has shown that wireless radiation "affects living organisms at levels well below most international and national guidelines." These effects are seen at non-thermal radiation levels cannot be explained by heating. Thus, the current guidelines (10 000 mW/m2) based on heating are at least 10 000 times too high (Resolution 1815 = 1 mW/m2) and do not protect childrens' health.
